



Subject-Notification of TB cases

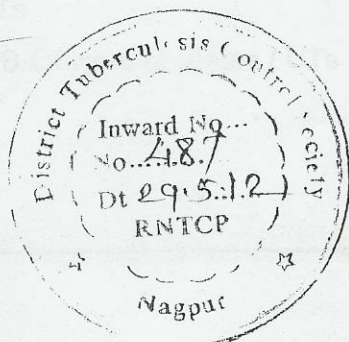
Ref- Govt of India, MoHFW, New Delhi letter no Z-28015/2/2012-TB dated 7 May 2012 (copy enclosed)

As per the letter under reference it is heartening to note that the Govt. of India has declared Tuberculosis as Notifiable Disease. It is therefore necessary to notify every tuberculosis case by all health care providers to the District Health Officer (for rural area and Municipal council) and to the medical officer (Health) of the Municipal corporation (for corporation area).

For the purpose of cases notification a Tuberculosis case is defined as follows:

- A patient diagnosed with at least one sputum specimen positive for acid fast bacilli, or Culture -positive for Mycobacterium tuberculosis, or RNTCP endorsed Rapid Diagnostic molecular test positive for tuberculosis

OR





- A patient diagnosed clinically as case of tuberculosis, without microbiologic confirmation and initiated on anti TB drugs.

The notification is to be done in the enclosed proforma. The notification is to be done by government health institutions, the health institutions run by NGO sector and also by the private practitioners.

When the tuberculosis case is notified following actions need to be taken

1. All private practitioners and health providers are to be informed about the GOI guidelines
2. The contacts of the TB patients are to be traced and if they are having cough of any duration, should be examined for tuberculosis.
3. The Notified tuberculosis case should be followed up by DTO/CTO for regular treatment. If the patient is defaulted, immediate retrieval actions are to be taken to ensure regular treatment. During the default retrieval if it is observed that the treatment is discontinued because of cost of drug not affordable to the patient then DTO/CTO should contact the patient and convince him to start anti tuberculosis treatment from government sector.
4. If the notified case is from NGO/pvt practitioner the concern NGO /Pvt Practitioner can be involved under various NGO/PP schemes under RNTCP. The DTO/CTO should take necessary action for the same

**Notification of TB cases**

TB continues to be a major public health problem accounting for substantial morbidity and mortality in the country. Early diagnosis and complete treatment of TB is the corner-stone of TB prevention and control strategy. Inappropriate diagnosis and irregular/incomplete treatment with anti-TB drugs may contribute to complications, disease spread and emergence of Drug Resistant TB.

In order to ensure proper TB diagnosis and case management, reduce TB transmission and address the problems of emergence and spread of Drug Resistant-TB, it is essential to have complete information of all TB cases. Therefore, the healthcare providers shall notify every TB case to local authorities i.e. District Health Officer / Chief Medical Officer of a district and Municipal health Officer of a Municipal Corporation / Municipality every month in a given format (attached).


For the purpose of case notification, a TB case is defined as follows:

- A patient diagnosed with at least one sputum specimen positive for acid fast bacilli, or Culture-positive for *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, or RNTCP endorsed Rapid Diagnostic molecular test positive for tuberculosis
- OR
- A patient diagnosed clinically as a case of tuberculosis, without microbiologic confirmation, and initiated on anti-TB drugs.

For the purpose of this notification, healthcare providers will include clinical establishments run or managed by the Government (including local authorities), private or NGO sectors and/or individual practitioners.


